CHILDREN'S PROJECT

* GIFTS FROM OUR FATHER ABOVE *

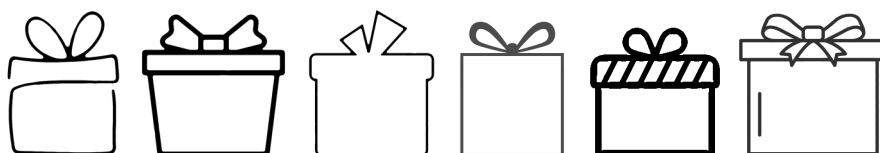
**"Every good gift and every perfect gift is
from above, coming down from the Father"
(James 1:27)**

* SUPPLIES NEEDED *

**Blank paper (several sheets)
Markers, colored pencils, or crayons
Scissors & Tape**

* STEP ONE *

**Draw several gift-boxes like the ones shown below.
Make them about 4 inches wide.
Leave blank space inside to write later (see step 2).**



* STEP TWO *

**In the blank space on each gift-box, write or draw
something you are thankful for (gifts from God)!**

* STEP THREE *

**After you're finished decorating your gift-boxes,
use scissors to cut them out carefully.**

* STEP FOUR *

**Get your parents to help you tape your finished
products to a wall, mirror or door where you will
be reminded often of God's good gifts!**

CHILDREN'S PROJECT

* FAITH BY WORKS *

"I will show you my faith by my works."
(James 2:18)

* SUPPLIES NEEDED *

Blank paper
Markers, colored pencils or crayons

* STEP ONE *

Write the word FAITH in bubble letters.
Use BIG letters to make the word fill the page!
Start with pencil, then trace over with a marker.

The word "FAITH" is written in large, bold, bubble-style capital letters. Each letter is an outline, designed for children to trace over with a marker after writing it lightly with a pencil.

* STEP TWO *

Think of 5 different good works Christians can do.
(Examples: visit widows, send cards, share meals,
rake leaves, help the poor, teach the gospel, etc.)

* STEP THREE *

Inside each of the 5 letters, draw a different good
work from your list (see step 2). Color and label.

* STEP FOUR *

Hang up your work and be reminded to do good!

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CHILDREN'S PROJECT

* WORDS THAT BLESS OTHERS *

**"From the same mouth come blessing and cursing.
My brothers, these things ought not to be so...
A harvest of righteousness is sown in peace
by those who make peace."
(James 3:10,18)**

* SUPPLIES NEEDED *

**Blank paper
Markers, colored pencils or crayons**

* STEP ONE *

Draw a mouth in the center of your paper.



* STEP TWO *

Draw several word bubbles all around the mouth!



* STEP THREE *

**Inside each word bubble, write words you can say
to bless others this week.**

* STEP FOUR *

Hang up your work and be reminded to bless others!

CHILDREN'S PROJECT

* DRAW NEAR TO GOD *

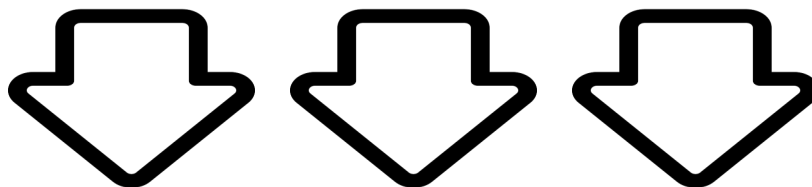
"Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you."
(James 4:8)

* SUPPLIES NEEDED *

Blank paper & markers, colored pencils or crayons

* STEP ONE *

At the very top of your paper, write "GOD".
Then, on the top-half of your paper,
draw 3 big block-arrows pointing DOWN.



* STEP TWO *

At the very bottom of your paper, write your name.
Then, on the bottom-half of your paper,
draw 3 big block-arrows pointing UP.



* STEP THREE *

Inside each DOWN arrow, draw/write something
that GOD has done to draw near to you.

Then, inside each UP arrow, draw/write something
that YOU can do to draw near to God!

* STEP FOUR *

Hang up your work and keep drawing near to God!

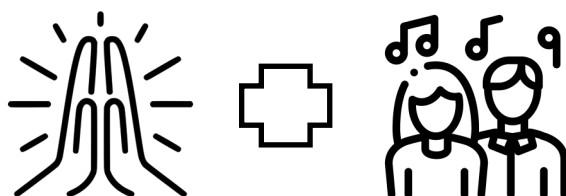
CHILDREN'S PROJECT

* REASONS TO PRAY & SING *

**"Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray.
Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing praise."
(James 5:13)**

* SUPPLIES NEEDED *

Blank paper & markers, colored pencils or crayons



* STEP ONE *

**Draw a vertical line down the middle of your paper.
On the LEFT side, at the top, write "PRAY".
On the RIGHT side, at the top, write "SING".**

* STEP TWO *

**On the LEFT side, under "PRAY", draw & label
some things you would like to pray about today.**

* STEP THREE *

**On the RIGHT side, under "SING", write some favorite
songs and draw a picture that goes along with each.**

* STEP FOUR *

**Gather with your family and spend a few minutes
praying and singing. Use your project as a guide!**

* STEP FIVE *

**Hang up your work and let it remind you to spend
some time praying and singing together each day!**

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
