# THE NIGHT COMETH

Boswell relates in the biography Life of Johnson that Samuel Johnson had the words "the night cometh' inscribed on the face of his watch. This made a great impression on his friend Sir Walter Scott. This is when he was very young, and not yet famous. In 1797 Scott married and some years later built his famous home at Abbotsford on the banks of the River Tweed, south of Edinburg, Scotland. It is a lovely place surrounded by beautiful lawns and formal gardens. In the center of the main garden Scott placed a sundial which had the words inscribed, "the night cometh." Later, after Scott had completed many of his famous works-Ivanhoe, The Lay of the Last Minstrel, and The Lady of the Lake—he was visiting some old friends and was stricken with some kind of attack that left him near death. He asked for horses and a chariot to take him home to Abbotsford quickly. He would not listen to his friends who urged him to stay the night. "No, this is a sad warning to me, I must go home to work while it is called day; the night cometh when no man can work. I put that text many a year ago on my dial stone, but it often preached in vain."

"I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day; the night cometh, when no man can work" (John 9:4).

"Man that is born of a woman is few days, and full of trouble. He cometh forth like a flower, and is cut down: he fleeth also as a shadow, and continueth not" (Job 14:12).
