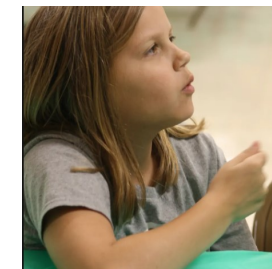
Single/Single Again:
