

EAST RIDGE FAMILY BIBLE CLASS – I JOHN CHAPTER ONE

CHILDREN'S PROJECT

* WALKING IN THE LIGHT *

"...Walk in the light, as he is in the light..."
(I John 1:7)

* SUPPLIES NEEDED *

Blank paper & markers, colored pencils or crayons
A flashlight & tape

* STEP ONE *


At the top of your page, write: "WALK IN THE LIGHT."

* STEP TWO *

Line off the rest of your paper into 4 sections,
then shade each section a different color.

* STEP THREE *

In each colored section, write a way you can walk in the light (obey, serve, worship, study). Black marker!



* STEP FOUR *

Roll your paper into a cylinder and tape it to your flashlight to make a light tunnel.

* STEP FIVE *

Go explore a dark room and remember that God gives you the light you need to live and explore life!

CHILDREN'S PROJECT

* HOW LONG WILL IT LAST? *

**"The world is passing away along with its desires,
but whoever does the will of God abides forever."
(I John 2:17)**

* SUPPLIES NEEDED *

Blank paper & markers, colored pencils or crayons

* STEP ONE *

Draw a line down the middle of your paper.

* STEP TWO *

**At the top-left, write: "THINGS THAT WON'T LAST!"
Below, write/draw things that won't last forever.
(Examples: toys, phones, sports, food, clothes, etc.)**



* STEP THREE *

**At the top-right, write: "THINGS THAT LAST FOREVER!"
Below, write/draw things that will last forever.
(Examples: God's Word, church, faith, hope, love, etc.)**

* STEP FOUR *

**Hang up your project as a reminder to
focus most on the things that will last forever!**

*** LOVING ONE ANOTHER ***

**"For this is the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another."
(I John 3:11)**

*** SUPPLIES NEEDED ***


Blank paper & markers, colored pencils or crayons

*** STEP ONE ***

Write "LOVE ONE ANOTHER" at the top of your page.

*** STEP TWO ***

**Draw and color a heart in the middle of your page.
Make the heart about the size of you hand.
Then draw lines going out from the heart as shown.**



*** STEP THREE ***

**In each of the four sections around the heart,
write/draw a way that you can show love to others.**

*** STEP FOUR ***

**Hang up your project as a reminder to
love one another!**

CHILDREN'S PROJECT

*** CASTING OUT FEAR ***

**"There is no fear in love,
but perfect love casts out fear."
(I John 4:18)**

*** SUPPLIES NEEDED ***

Blank paper & markers, colored pencils or crayons

*** STEP ONE ***

Write "I WILL NOT FEAR" at the top of your page.

*** STEP TWO ***

**Draw a big red circle with a line like the one below.
Make it as big as you can (fill your entire page)
so you will have space inside (see next step).**



*** STEP THREE ***

**Inside the circle, write/draw some things that you
choose to no longer fear because of God's love.**

*** STEP FOUR ***

**Hang up your project as a reminder to
allow perfect love to cast out fear!**

CHILDREN'S PROJECT

*** FAITH IS THE VICTORY ***

"This is the victory that
overcomes the world—our faith."
(I John 5:2)

*** SUPPLIES NEEDED ***


Blank paper & markers, colored pencils or crayons

*** STEP ONE ***

Turn your paper sideways (landscape), and then
write "FAITH IS THE VICTORY" across the top.

*** STEP TWO ***

Draw several big boxes below (4 to 6 boxes).



*** STEP THREE ***

In each box, write/draw an example of faithfulness
that overcomes worldliness. OR, you can make a
comic-book style story about faithfulness!

*** STEP FOUR ***

Hang up your project and be an overcomer!

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
