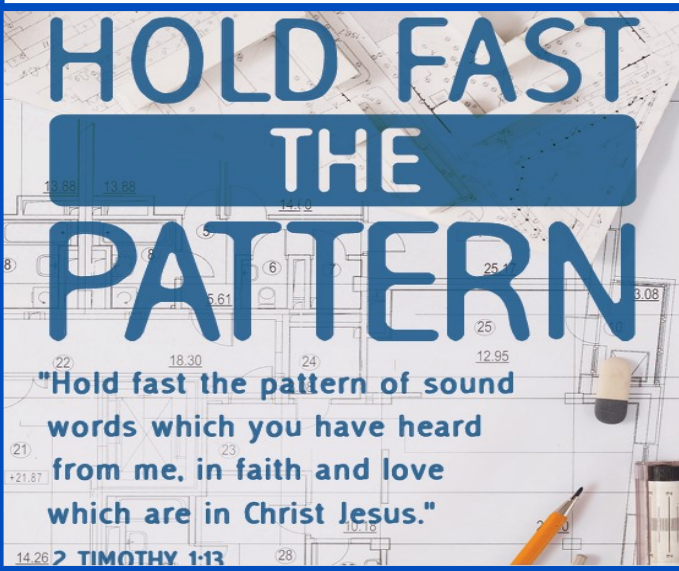

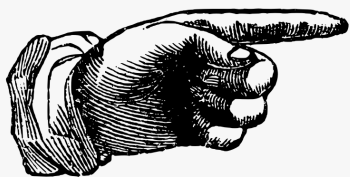

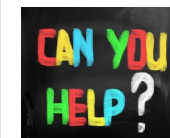
Senior Members Evening Trip:
